

Amazing Library Race F.A.Q.



When is it?

- **Friday, August 17, 2007, 1-3 p.m.**

What is it?

- An orientation event meant to connect new students with friendly faces in the Library and to familiarize new students with the physical building, the library collections and the services provided by the University Libraries. The emphasis is on survival in the desert university, i.e. academic survival and getting comfortable here.

Why are we doing it?

- We believe that if students interact with us informally at the beginning of their academic careers they will be more likely to come and ask for our help the entire time they are here at the university.

Who can participate?

- Anyone is welcome! *Children under 15 must be accompanied by an adult at all times, as per Library policy.*
- You can choose to do the whole trail or only part.
- Restrictions apply to the pizza party and raffle (see below).

How does it work?

- You follow the map and instructions to 13 stops in the Main Library. At each stop, you must answer a question or do an activity, after which your entry form will be stamped. It's easy and fun—and you'll learn about the Library!

How long will it take?

- The minimum amount of time to do the whole trail takes at least 30 minutes.
- The minimum amount of time to do a partial trail takes at least 15 minutes.

Where does it begin/end?

- Begins outside the Main Library entrance
- Ends downstairs in the ILC courtyard

Are there prizes?

- Free carabiner w/compass keychain to anyone who starts the Race—*one per person, while supply lasts.*
- Free water bottle to those who collect 4 stamps—*one per person, while supply lasts.*

What's being raffled?

- To enter the raffle you must be UA-affiliated (student, staff, faculty) and have collected at least 8 stamps.
- Prizes will include iPods, spa gift certificates, T-shirts and many prizes from local area merchants.
- Raffle will be held after the event. Winners will be notified by August 27th and also announced in the Arizona Daily Wildcat newspaper.
- UA CatCard required to pick up prizes. Prizes must be picked up by Tuesday, September 11, 2007.

Will there be food?

- Eegee's & pizza at the finish line in the ILC courtyard—*while supplies last.*
- Those who've collected at least 8 stamps can join the party.
